

**York Racecourse - Going Report**  
**Tuesday 12/08/14 at 3:30pm**

The official ground description remains good-to-soft following rainfall of 20mm on Sunday 10 August, with an additional 2mm during Monday. The Going Stick reading was 6.2 at 14.45pm on Tuesday 12 August.

The Met Office forecasts the possibility of showers and rain through Tuesday late afternoon and evening, then turning mainly dry and breezy with the chance of some showers from Wednesday until this weekend.

York's Assistant Clerk of the Course, Anthea Morshead, said "The going is still good-to-soft ahead of next week's Welcome to Yorkshire Ebor Festival. We are very pleased with the condition of the racing surface with an excellent, dense sward and the grass looks in excellent health. There are some showers forecast, with the possibility of rain tonight but then the forecast turns mainly dry and breezy from Wednesday morning until the weekend, according to the Met Office forecast".
