

**York Racecourse - Going Report**  
**Thursday 14/08/14 at 8am**

The official ground description remains Good-to-Soft, Good in places and a Goingstick reading of 6.3. It has been dry since 4mm of rain on Tuesday evening.

Current conditions on Thursday morning are dry and bright.

The Met Office five day forecasts through to Monday 18 August is a mixture of bright, blustery, fresh conditions with the chance of localised, passing scattered showers.

Anthea Morshead, Assistant Clerk of the Course, said at 8am on Thursday 14 August: "The wind is much lighter this morning than it has been recently, and it is a cool, bright, clear morning. The ground is continuing to slowly dry out after a wet weekend in Yorkshire last weekend. The current going of Good to Soft, Good in places may dry further if we miss the showers over the next few days but it will not dry quickly as the nights are cool and the daytime temperatures are not hot. We are pleased with the condition of the course ahead of next weeks Welcome to Yorkshire Ebor Festival."
